Recipes include OAK at Fourteenth's famous Kale Salad, Santo's unforgettable Red Chili Pozole, and Colorado-inspired Cactus and Corn Fritters from Zolo Grill. At least 50 percent of the proceeds from book sales will be split evenly between all participating restaurants.

In her first year as producer, First Bite saw a more than 30 percent jump in diners. Through partnerships with over 68 restaurants, nonprofits, local businesses and organizations, the 2019 First Bite delivered over \$542,000 economic impact to Boulder County.
